## *Previous Year's Highlights* School Year 2019-2020 / Fiscal Year 2020

#### Pre-COVID-19 Pandemic (July 1, 2019 – March 1, 2020)

- Investment was completed in a new K-12 Next Generation Science Standard aligned textbook /techbook series
- Purchase of Phase 1 of 2 of Elementary ELA curriculum
- Resources were realigned to address student behavior needs
- The Board approved the final report of the Strategic Facilities Committee

#### COVID-19 Response (March 1 – June 30, 2020)

- Continuity of Learning Plan Instructional services transitioned quickly to a virtual environment
- Food Service pivoted to "summer feeding" model
- Recovery & Reopening Plan development began while staff worked remotely

#### Fiscal Year 2020 Financial Highlights

- \$437,923 of Fund Balance was utilized for Capital projects
- Food Service Fund ended the year with a deficit of \$362,080
- Medical Assistance balance ended the year down \$185,680

#### Use of Federal Funds – CARES Act funding

- Summer Programming Jump Start
- Investment to stand up virtual learning environment
  - Professional Development
  - Student & Staff Devices
  - Community & household hot spots
- Additional Nurses & Tech Support
- Supported additional custodial needs & air quality initiative

#### **Community Response**

- Food Service pivoted to "summer feeding" model
- Nurses partnered with GCHD for testing and vaccinations

#### **Unrestricted Funds Reallocated**

- Forward purchased Phase 2 of Elementary ELA curriculum
- Matched state funding for Security Vestibules at 2 schools
- Custodians & Maintenance staff have been deployed to provide additional cleaning & disinfecting second staff

# **Additional Highlights**

Dominated the state of Maryland in CTE Programs

- First in the state to have JROTC approved as a CTE completer program
- 100% CTE Graduation rate
- 1 of only 2 counties to reach 100% in attainment of Recognized Credentials

Instructional & Administrative departments collaborated to review, recommend, purchase, and implement the *Schoology* LMS with a very rapid timeline in response to virtual needs.

- Federal & state restricted funds will be braided to provide additional resources & supports

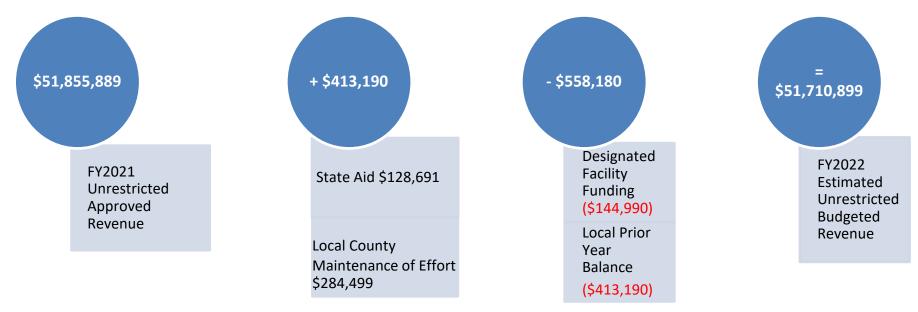

#### Move GCPS Forward

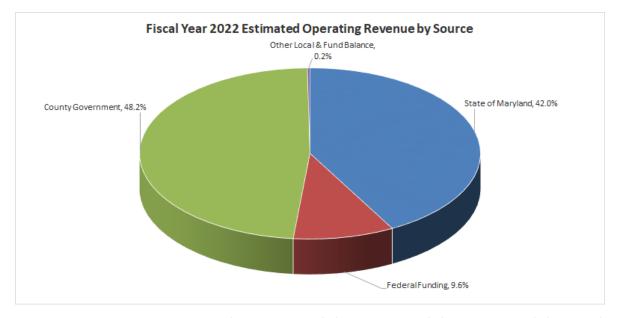
- Fund Balance will be utilized for the implementation of the Board's strategic facilities plan

## FY 2022 Proposed Unrestricted Operating Budget Reconciliation Budgeted Revenue





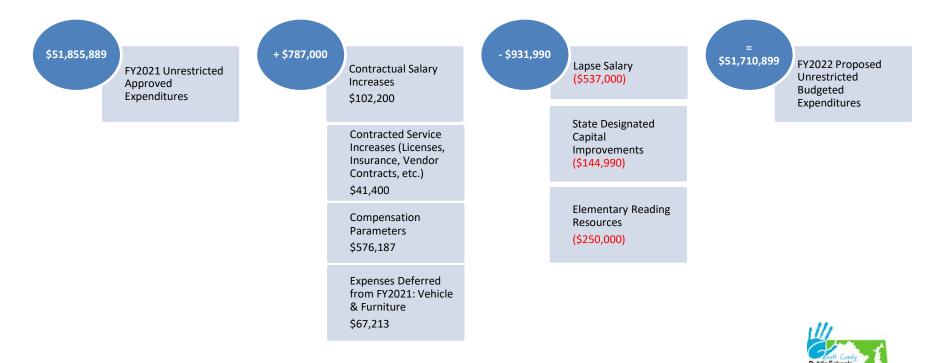

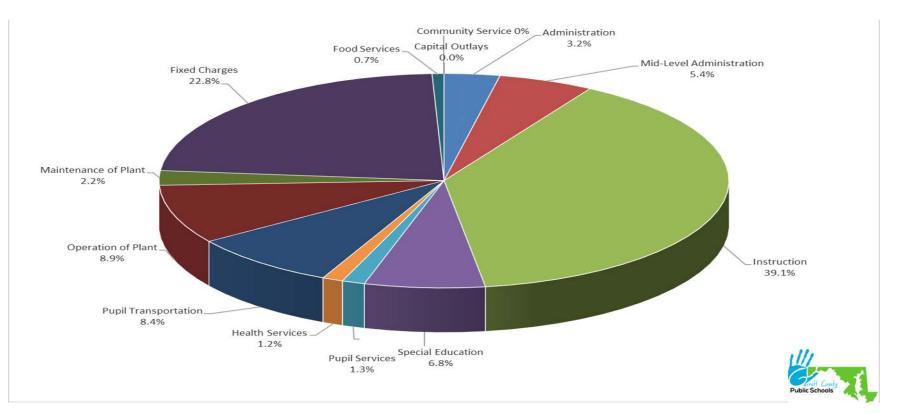

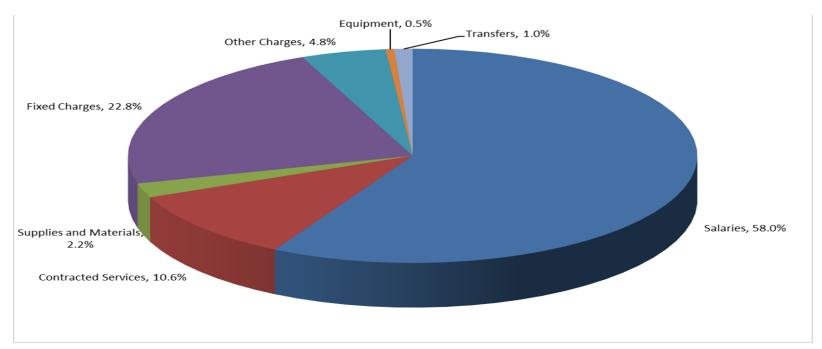

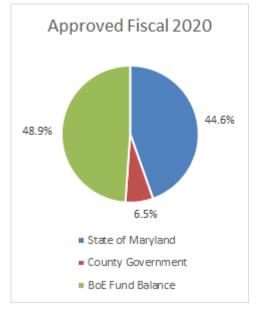
- State & Local Cost Split changes

- Allowable costs for State participation expanded

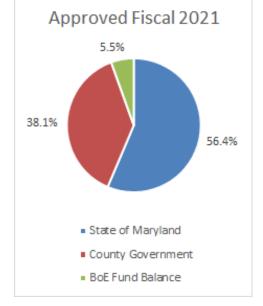
#### **Strategic Facilities Committee Final Report**

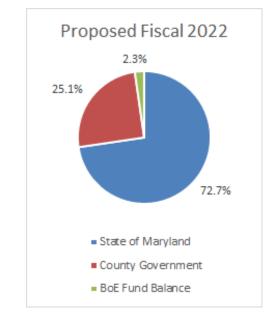
- Board accepted the report & approved it

#### Northern High School Improvements

- \$16,000 HVAC for Gym/Band section (A&E)
- \$250,000 Parking Lot Lighting & Paving Project (Construction)
- \$19,000 Mechanical/Boiler Replacement (A&E)

#### Grantsville Elem Open Space Conversion & Roof Replacement

- \$666,000 Planning (A&E + Contingency)
- \$407,000 (Construction)

#### Route Forty Elem Mechanical/Boiler Replacement

• \$19,000 - Planning (A&E)

Total Request of \$1,377,000, down \$708,000 from prior year's approved budget
