- 2. The County authorizes the sale of the Property to the Town for the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00).
- 3. The Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners of Garrett County, Maryland, be and is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents as may be necessary or required in conjunction with the sale and conveyance of the Property to the Town.
- 4. This Resolution shall be effective upon its adoption.

1. A request by the Board of County Commissioners that the Maryland General Assembly amend the Garrett County Maryland Code of Ordinance, Section 30.21 BIDS AND CONTRACTS

FOR the purpose of authorizing the County Commissioners of Garrett County to enter into a certain contract for the purchase of an indeterminate amount of goods or services, on an as-needed basis over a period of time, without advertising for bids and authorizing the purchase of one or more vehicles without advertising for bids if the amount involved does not exceed \$100,000.

2. A request by the Board of County Commissioners that the Maryland General Assembly amend the Garrett County Maryland Code of Ordinance, Section 37.070 TAX IMPOSED

FOR the purpose of altering the definition of "hotel" for the hotel rental tax in Garrett County to include transient vacation rental units; altering the definition of "transient charge" for purposes of the county hotel rental tax; adding the definition of a "short-term" rental platform; requiring certain short-term rental platforms and other persons to perform certain duties and be subject to certain penalties related to the collection and remittance of the county hotel tax.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, The Public Local Laws of Garrett County Section 37.070 Section 20-401, 20-405.1

Add the definition of Transient Vacation Rental Unit and a Short-Term Rental Platform. By defining and including the internet based rental companies in this section, the legislation would enable the County to require internet based rental services, such as Airbnb, VBRO, etc. to collect and remit Accommodation Tax to the County when a unit is rented. Our county-based property management companies do an outstanding job of collecting and remitting the tax; however, many of the on-line rental services do not collect the tax.

3. <u>Legislative Bond</u> A request by the Board of County Commissioners that the Maryland General Assembly provide a Legislative Bond in the amount of \$150,000 for the following project:

#### **Bio-Mass Demonstration Project**

Garrett County explored developing and implementing a bio-mass project in response to Maryland's Energy Performance Standards and has worked with members of the USFS Wood Energy Technical Assistance Team to gain an understanding of facility needs and layout.

The County has identified a project that may present acceptable financial performance if grants can be leveraged. Additional benefits include keeping energy dollars in the local economy, supporting good forest management, reduction in net GHG emissions, avoidance of biogenic waste being landfilled, reduction in peak electric grid demands, and redundancy in heating fuels.

In order to pursue grant opportunities, we are required to have a pre-engineer study (PER) to determine feasibility and estimated project cost. We estimate the PER to be \$300,000-\$350,000. Our request is for a Legislative Bond in the amount of \$150,000 towards the PER.
